Our Islands

The Maltese Islands have long been a special destination for travellers. Lying at the centre of the Mediterranean, 90 km south of Sicily, the tiny archipelago was destined to be a meeting place for myriad cultures. Close to mainland Europe, yet far enough away to provide a real break from the familiar, the Maltese Islands are a natural choice for conference and incentive travel.

Blessed with a superb climate all year round, stunning architecture and natural beauty, the Islands offer the ideal location for combining business and leisure. In Malta, you can enjoy an array of activities in one of the most eclectic destinations in the Mediterranean.

English speaking, yet with a distinct southern exuberance, the Islands are a rare blend of relaxed living and cosmopolitan bustle. Malta and its sister Islands of Gozo and Comino each have their own charm and character, which means you can combine several choices of venue and entertainment during your stay. Prehistoric temples rub shoulders with baroque palaces and magnificent fortifications to provide a spectacular backdrop to your hospitality program. For a splash of live local colour, join the merriment of Malta's extravagant 'festas'. Pageantry and pre-history with panache: anything is possible during a stay in Malta.

Malta's climate is typical of the Mediterranean and is strongly influenced by the sea. The Maltese Islands have a pleasantly sunny climate with a daily average of around 12 hours sunshine in summer going down to 5 to 6 hours in mid winter. Summers are hot, dry and very sunny. Day-time temperatures in summer are often mitigated by cooling sea breezes. Spring and autumn are cooler, except when the occasional Scirocco wind from Africa brings unseasonally high temperatures and humidity. Winters are mild, with the occasional short cold spells brought about by the north and north-easterly winds from central Europe. Annual rainfall is low, averaging 568mm a year. Bathing in the sea is quite possible well into the 'winter' months, and the peak beach season can last until mid- to late October.
