

# WHAT'S NEW EXPRESS RAIL LINK

The 26km-long Express Rail Link (XRL), which connects Hong Kong, Shenzhen, and from Guangzhou to the rest of Mainland China, was completed in September 2018. The high-speed link departs from Kowloon and has cut travel time between Hong Kong and Shenzhen down to just 20 minutes, while Guangzhou is now less than an hour away. The XRL is expected to enhance Hong Kong's role as the southern gateway into Mainland China.
